

Bliss Butterflies



Bliss Butterflies is intended to engage children in a fun and educational way. It's completely up to you how you use the *Bliss Butterflies* activity sheets. You can adapt these for different age groups by picking themes relating to a particular curriculum, or simply use both sheets and treat *Bliss Butterflies* as a project for the whole class to work on.

Below we have added a suggested lesson plan for using the *Bliss Butterflies* sheets.



Start with the *Bliss Butterflies* activity sheet and go through the life cycle of a butterfly with the class, colouring in the pictures if you want.



Then, turning the page over, you could use the descriptions and diagrams to help explain symmetry. This is another activity the class can do – completing the symmetrical pictures.



Once you have completed the *Bliss Butterflies* activity sheets, you can relate everything the class have learned about the life cycle of a butterfly and symmetry to create a butterfly painting.



On the back of the *Bliss Butterflies* painting sheet you will find a brief description of how to do a symmetrical butterfly painting. There is also some information about Bliss and some fundraising ideas.



And on the front is where the class can paint their own Bliss Butterfly. There's a template here to help the class get started.



You could also use either of the activity sheets as homework.
