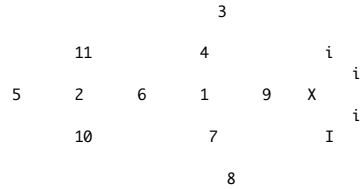


AEROPLANE NUMBERS

Here is a drawing of an aeroplane that uses all the numbers 1 to 11. They are placed so that the aircraft shows a total of 23 along each of wings (2) and body:



The secret of success is to put the right two numbers at the intersections (2 and 1, above). The other numbers can be placed in several ways and still show the right answer.

Still using 1 to 11, now build four more aircraft with totals of 25, 25, 28, 28 (sometimes, even the two critical numbers can also be varied).
