Myself Smart

These learners are able to reflect on their own learning carefully.

They like to work on their own. They try to understand their feelings, dreams and their strengths and weaknesses.

Their skills include:

- **Knowing their own strengths and weaknesses,**
- **Reflecting and analyzing themselves,**
- **Awareness of their inner feelings and dreams,**
- **Evaluating their thinking patterns,**
- **Understanding their relationship with others.**



Nature Smart

These learners enjoy doing nature projects.

They love plants and animals and the great outdoors. They have pets and like to bring bugs, flowers, leaves and other natural things to school to share with the class.

Their skills include:

- caring for animals,
- growing plants,
- collecting and sharing natural things,
- looking after the environment,
- finding patterns when they are out and about.



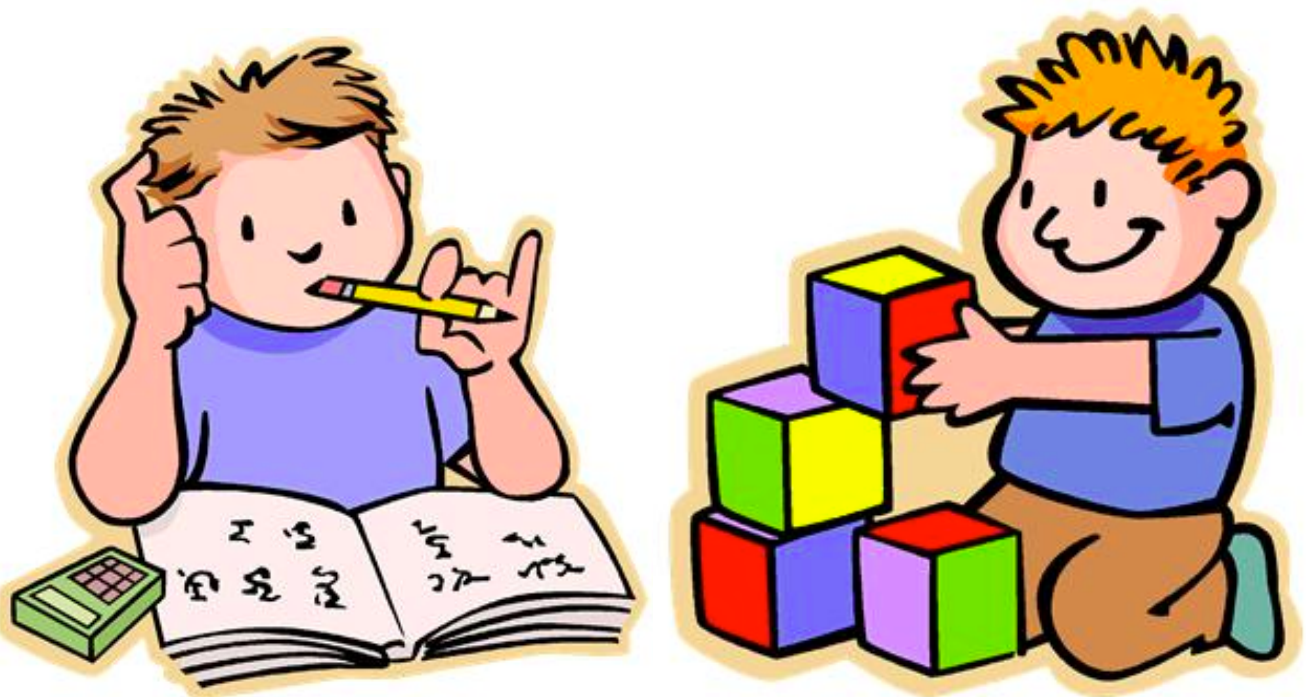
Number Smart

Word Smart

These learners express themselves through words and language.

They are good listeners and are usually good speakers. They think in words rather than pictures.

Picture Smart
