

Things to remember to include when writing a story.

- 1) Always use a capital letter at the start of a sentence.
- 2) Remember to use a full stop at the end of a sentence.
- 3) If you are asking a question within your text, use a question mark '?'
- 4) Be descriptive when describing things like setting or the characters feelings. For example;

James was feeling very nervous as he stood at the edge of the ragged, crumbling cliff.

Things to remember to include when writing a story

- 1) Remember your punctuation. For example;
 - a. Full stops.
 - b. Capital letters.
 - c. Speech marks for direct speech.
 - d. Question marks for questions.
- 2) Can you remember what a simile is? It is where you compare one thing to something else. For example; 'as quick as lightening' or 'as light as a feather'. Try to use at least two within your story.
- 3) Be descriptive. Really set the scene. For example;

James was feeling very nervous and worried as he stood at the edge of the ragged, crumbling cliff.

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
