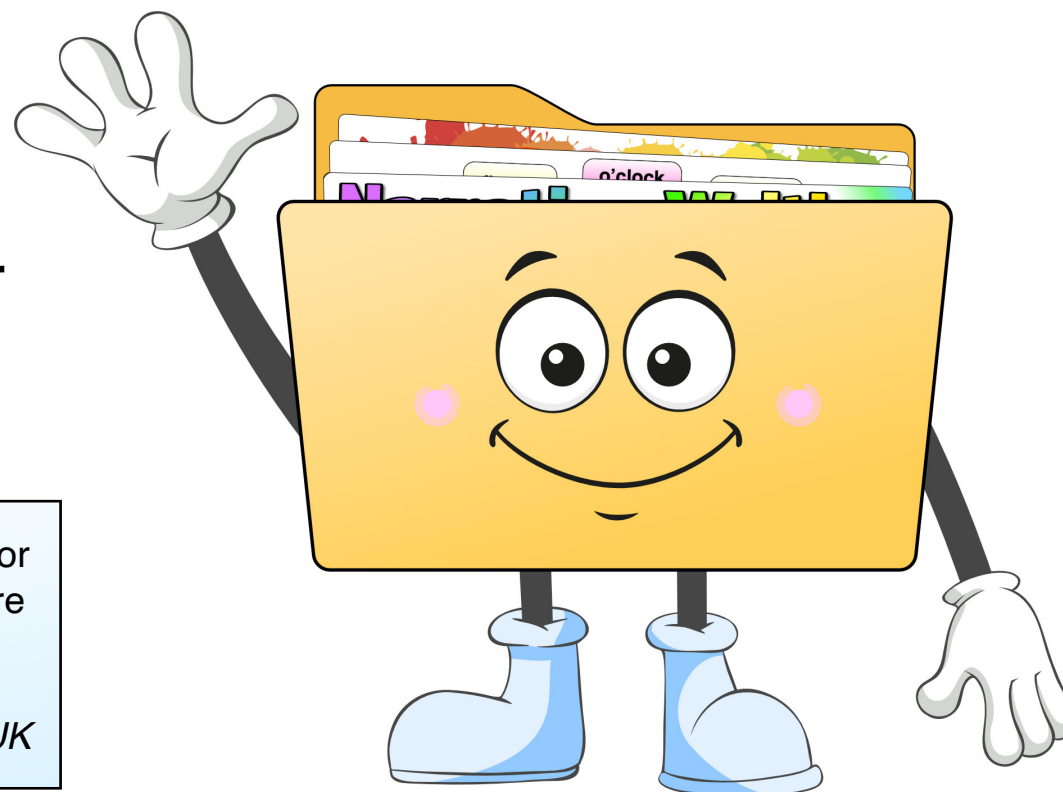

It's raining. Big grey clouds fill the sky, blotting out the sun. Raindrops sound like little drummers tapping on the roof.

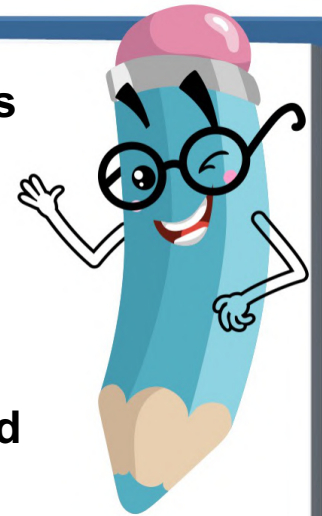
Outside, children splash through puddles in their waterproof wellies. People carry umbrellas or keep their hoods up.

3) Which phrase that tells us we cannot see the sun?

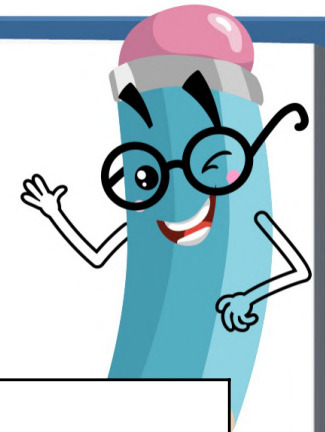
4) Write another sentence describing a rainy day.

Do you ever have a kiwi in your lunchbox. Did you know that there are two types of kiwi from New Zealand?

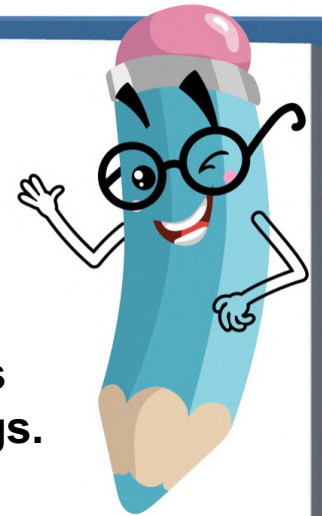

Once upon a time in the forest, a cheeky wolf said, "Hello, Red Riding Hood!"

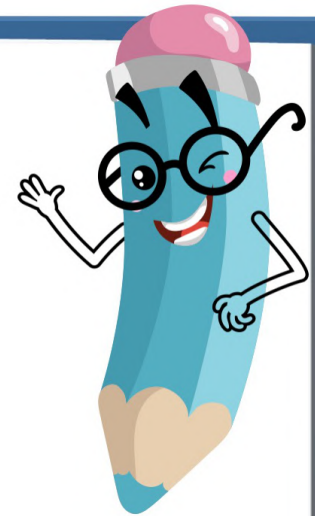

The plane soon leaves the city and flies over the countryside. From up above, the landscape seems like a painting. The winding rivers flow through the lush green forest like silva ribbons.

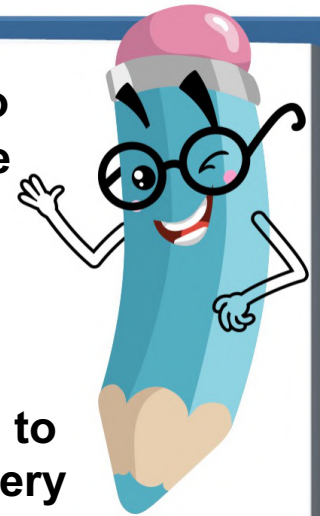
A village of tiny red-roofed houses, looking like toy houses, sits beside a blue lake. How different it is from the crowded city we are leaving behind!

3) Write another sentence to describe the landscape.

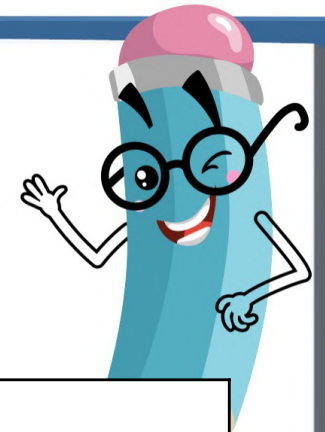

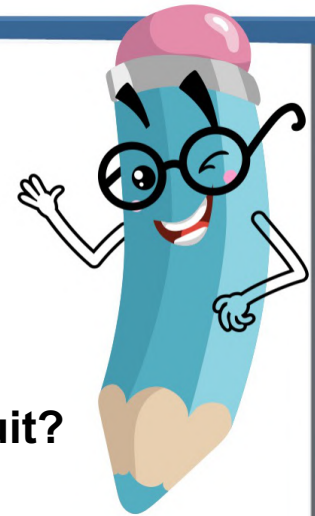
Fruit salad is a tasty and healthy treat for all!

3) Find the word that means the same as "easy".

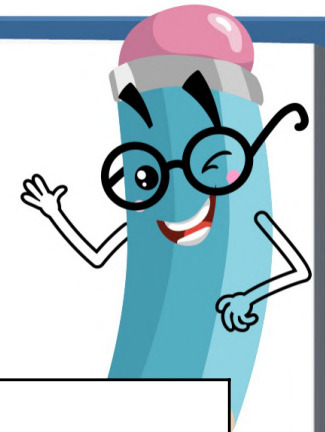
