We usually introduce people, places and things using nouns first. Then, we can use a pronoun instead.

Try using these pronouns:

He, Him, His
She, Her, Hers

I, Me, My, Mine
You, Your, Yours
We, Us, Our, Ours
They, Them, Their, Theirs

Another, Any, Both, Each,
Either, It, Its, Neither,
Nobody, None, Nothing,
One, Other, Some,
Somebody, Someone,
Something, That, These,
Those, What, Who, Whose
