# Features of Naradie White

Stories usually have the following features:



The characters are the people in a story. What is going to happen to them?

#### Settings

The setting tells us when and where the story takes place.

Plot The plot tells us what happens in the story (and the order that it happens in).

#### **Opening**

The start of the story.
The opening should catch the readers' attention and make them want to carry on reading!

#### Middle

The events in the middle of the story might include

- a **build-up** to a problem,
- the **problem** itself,
- and how it is resolved.

#### Ending

This explains what happens to the characters next and describes what they have learned.

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Here are some characters that could be used in a story. Can you think of any others?



# Oustanding Openings

The start of a story should 'hook' the reader and make them want to read on!

Can you start your stories in some of these ways?

#### In the middle of an action

George dived under the table when he heard the deafening noise outside.

#### <u>Opposites</u>

It was a <u>beautiful</u> day in Longwood Forest, but something <u>revolting</u> was hiding in the trees.

#### Sounds

'GRRRRR!'
The growling of the dog made Sam tremble in fear.

#### Questions

Was she too late?
What if she never got to see her family again?

#### Flashbacks

As I glanced out of the window, my mind drifted back to the last time I was here...

#### Speech

"Don't move!" Joe screamed to his younger brother.

#### Something Strange

North Park Junior School
was just like any other
school in the country... even
though the teachers were all
from a different planet.

#### Introduce a character

Peter was known for his honesty, but he had a secret that nobody else knew... until today.

#### Describe the setting

The house at the end of Broomstick Lane had been empty for years. Vines had formed a twisted maze over the windows and cobwebs covered the doors.

#### Exclamations

Mr. Simmonds was furious!






