



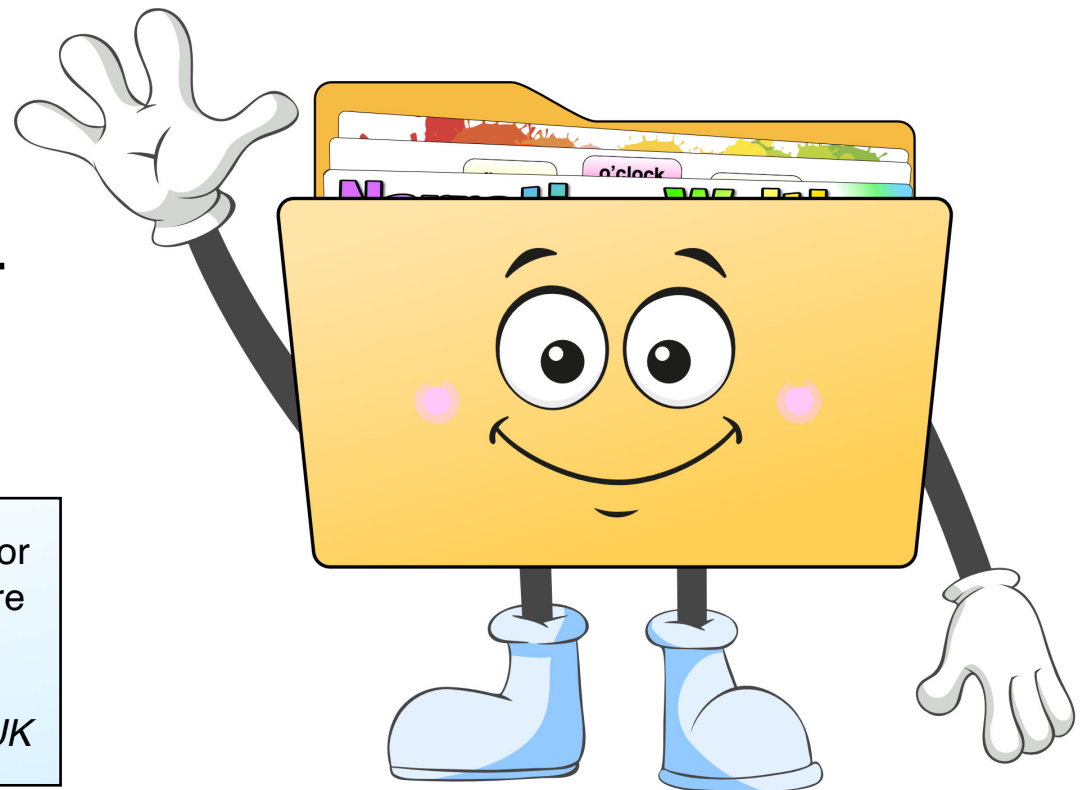
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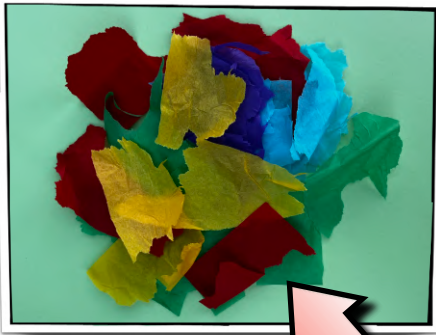
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Stained Glass Christmas Scenes

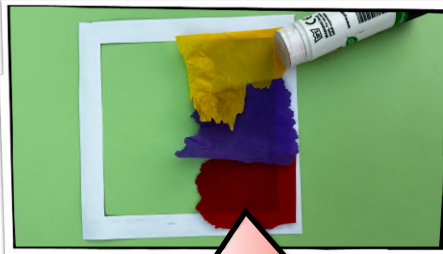
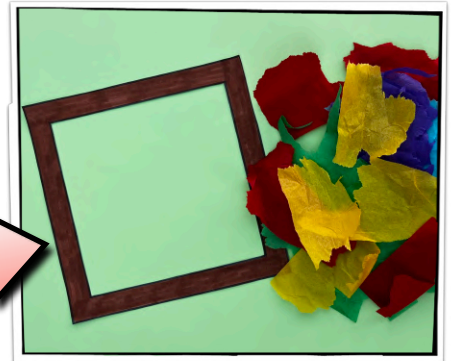


To make your scene, you will need:

- One of the templates provided, printed on paper or card,
- Coloured tissue paper,
- Colouring pens, scissors and glue.

1 Tear the tissue paper into small pieces.

2 Colour the picture frame and carefully cut it out. Don't forget to cut out the middle of the frame too.

Turn the frame over and glue a piece of tissue paper to the edge.

Continue sticking pieces of tissue paper, until the centre of the frame is completely filled.

Carefully cut out the Christmas shape and stick it to the front of the picture frame. Then hold your scene in front of a light!
