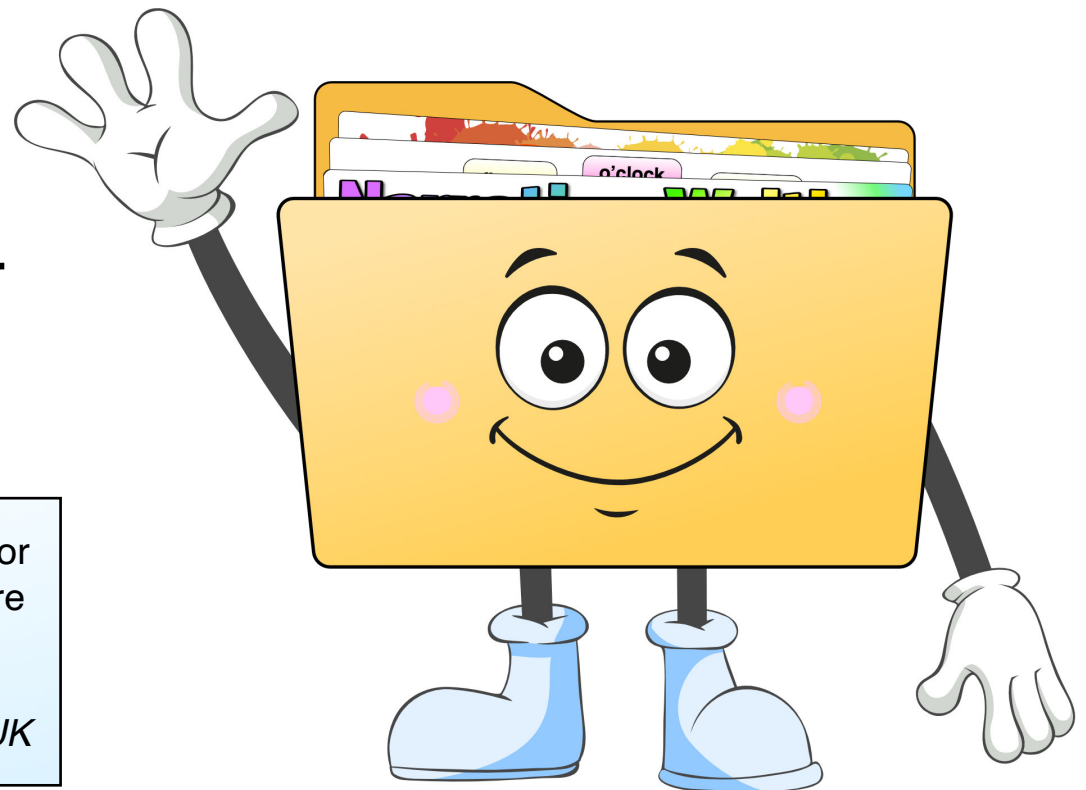

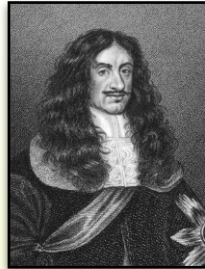


THE GREAT FIRE OF LONDON

Who?



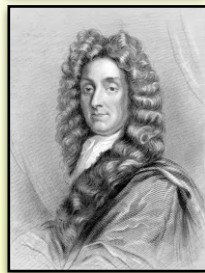
Thomas Farriner

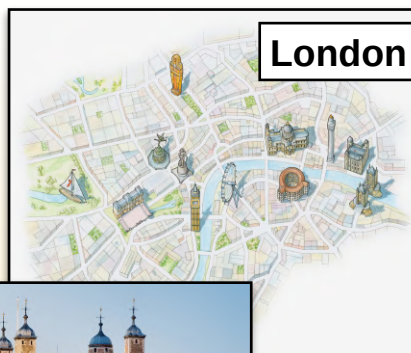

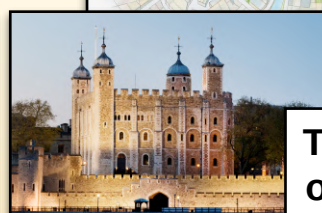
