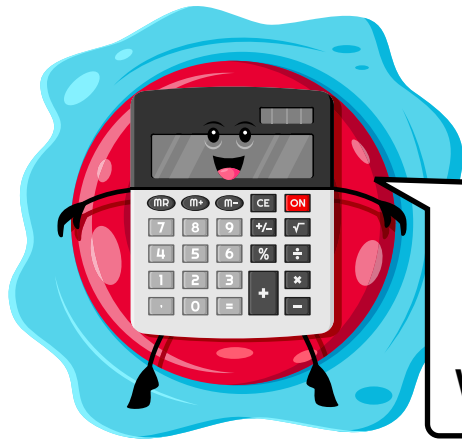




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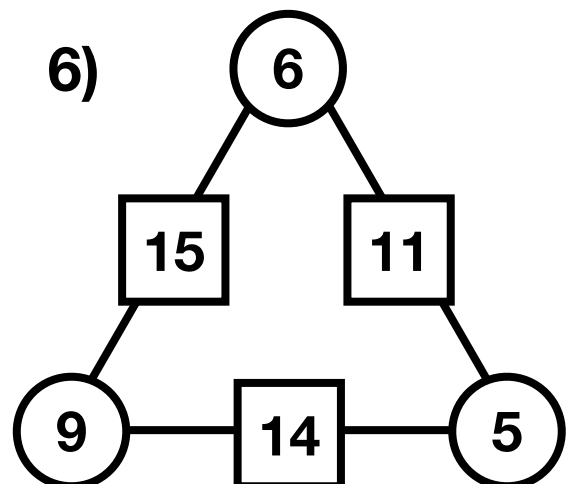
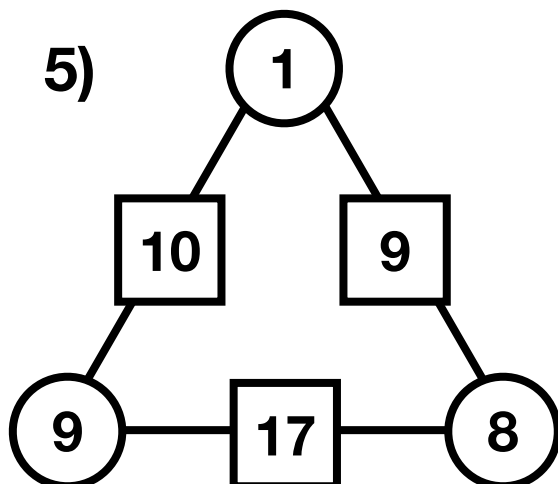
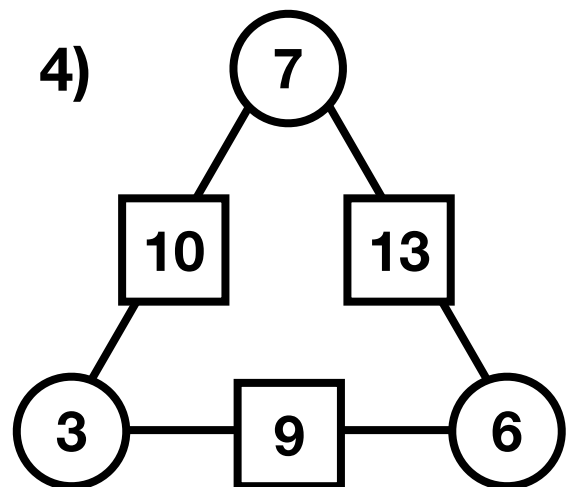
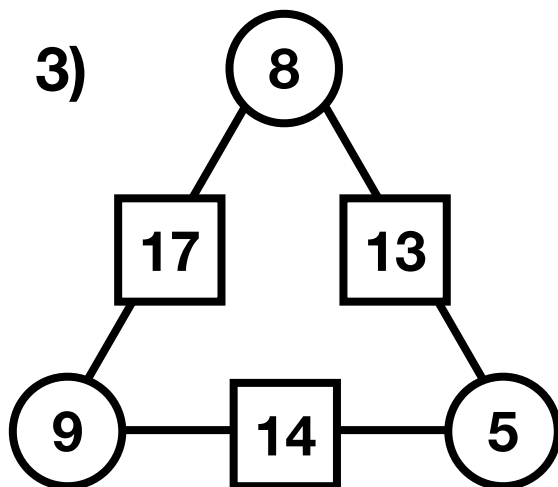
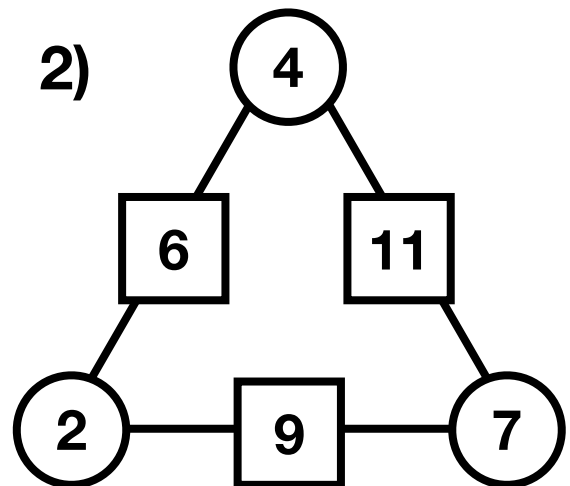
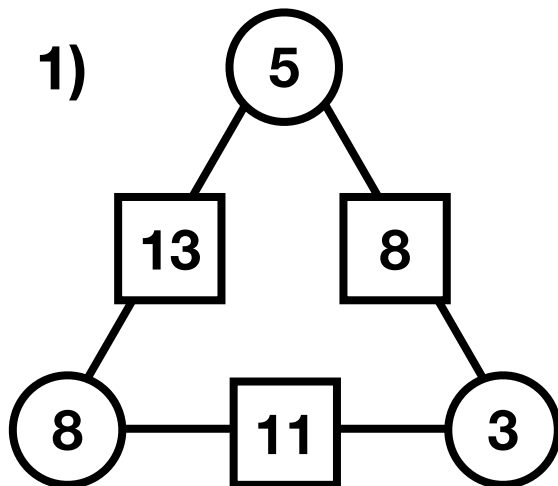
In an arithmagon, the numbers in the two circles (on each side of the triangle) add up to the number in the square between them. Write the missing numbers in these arithmagons.

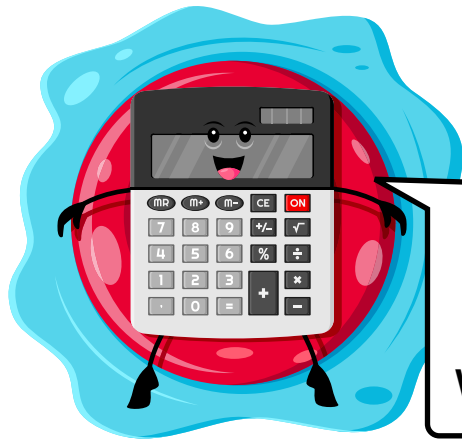




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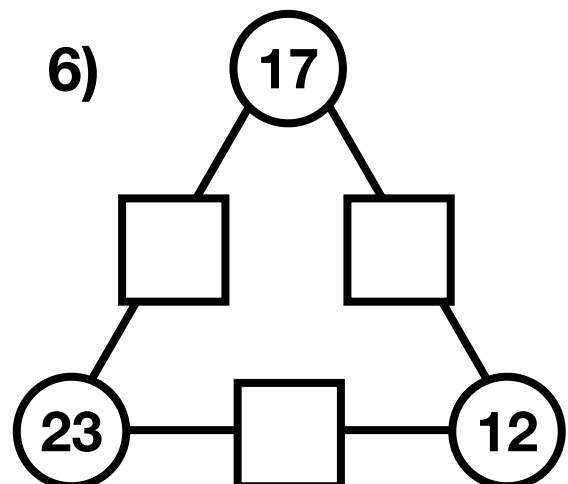
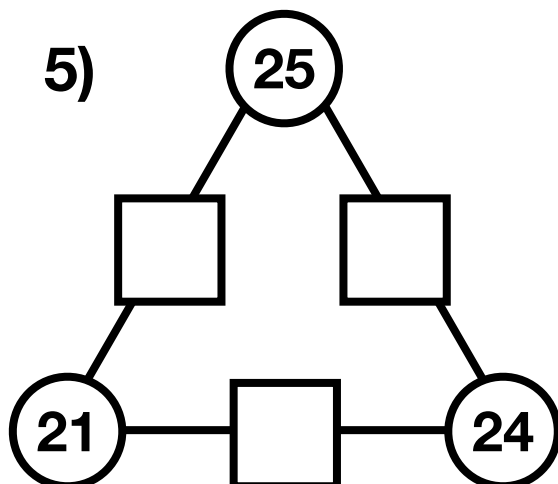
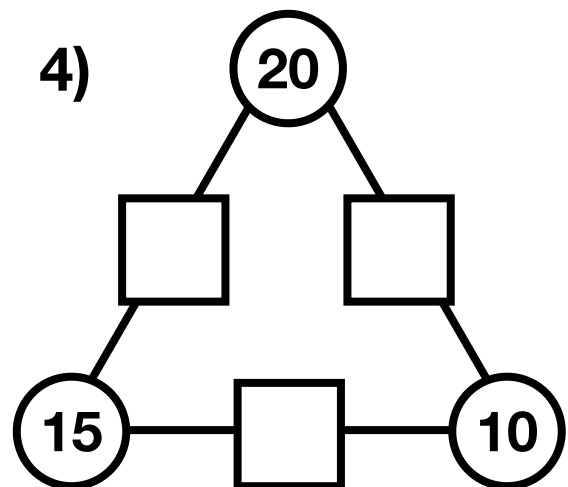
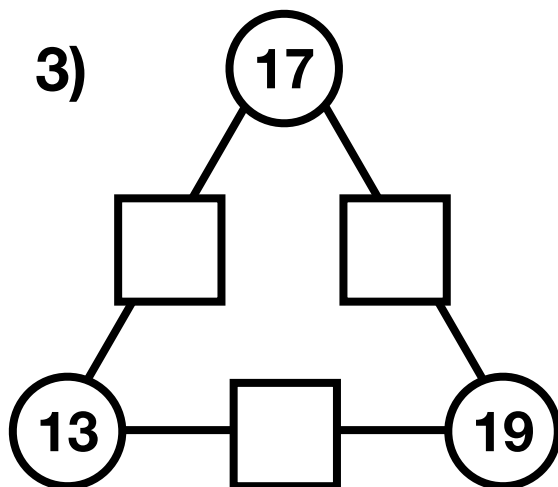
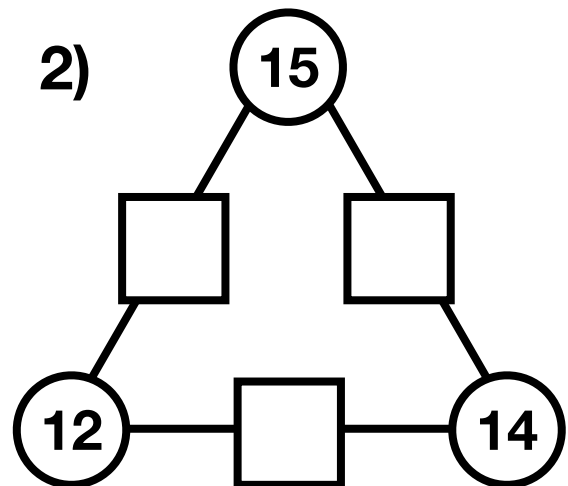
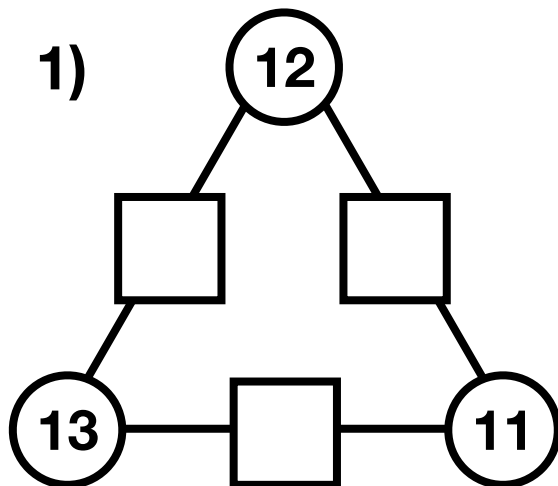
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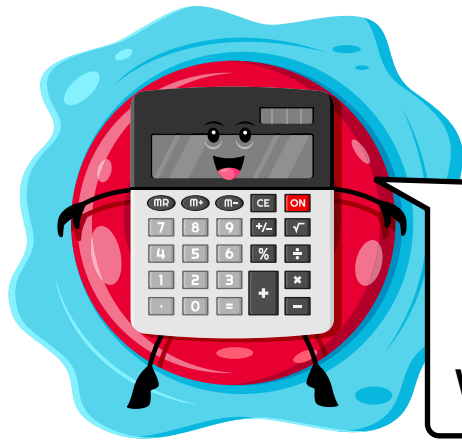




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
