Max plants 36 flowers in his garden. One third of them are tulips. How many tulips did he plant?

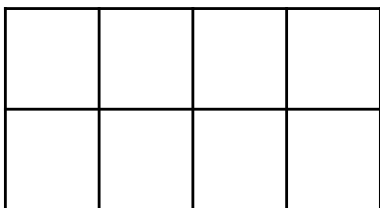
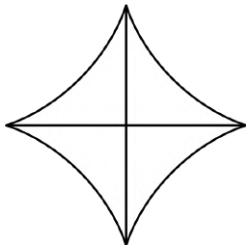
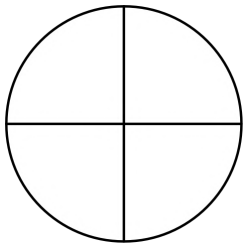
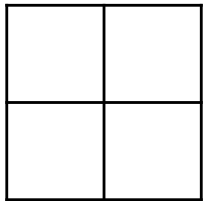


Did you know?

In photography and painting, the "rule of thirds" is a technique in which images are divided into a 3x3 grid. Important elements of the picture are placed along these lines or at the points where they cross.

Did you know?

One quarter of an hour is fifteen minutes, so fifteen minutes past the hour is 'quarter past' and fifteen minutes to the hour is 'quarter to'.
