

Greater than and less than



Hi there! It's me, Mad Max again!
Try adding the < and > symbols to these
pairs of numbers.
Remember, < means less than
> means greater (more) than
e.g, $10 > 5$ (10 is *greater than* 5)
 $5 < 10$ (5 is *less than* 10)
