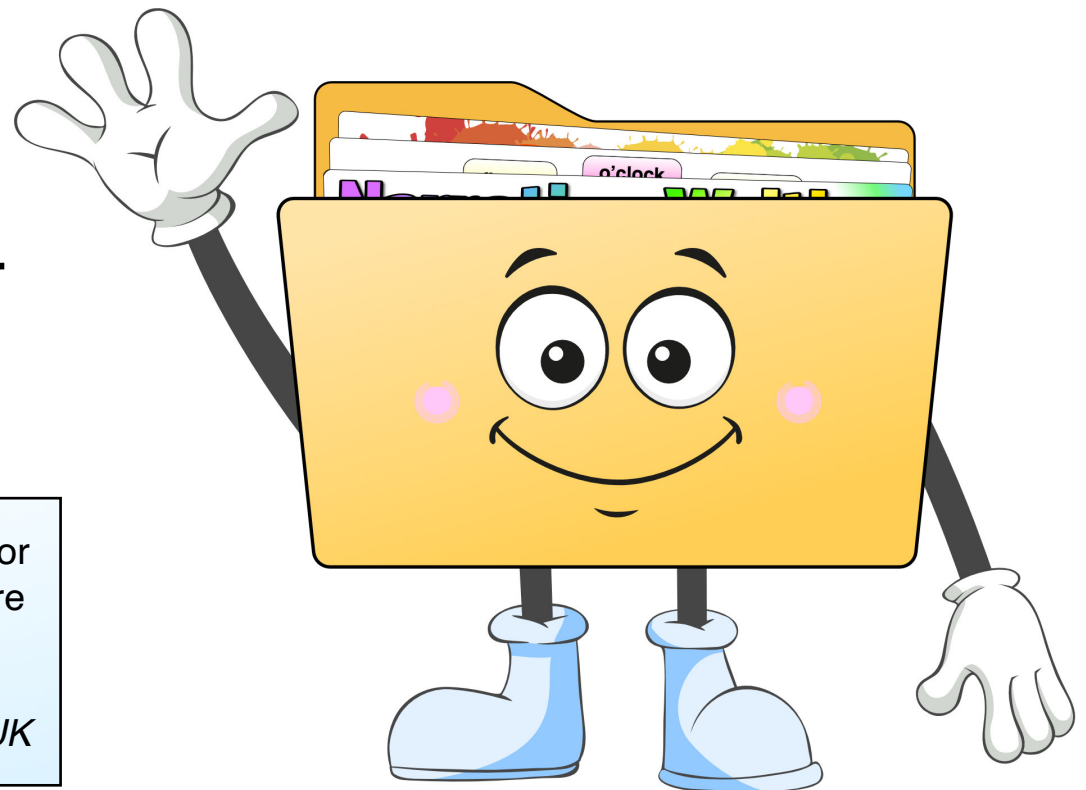
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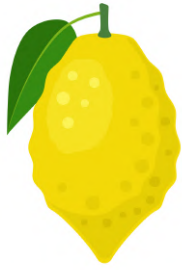
Sukkot



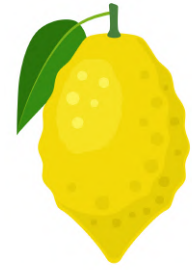
Can you match the words to their definitions?

Etrog	●	●	The Jewish holy text.
Four Species	●	●	A month in the Jewish calendar, that falls in the Autumn.
Lulav	●	●	Symbolic guests who are invited to eat in the Sukkah.
Sukkah	●	●	A tree that bears dates, a sweet oval fruit.
Sukkot	●	●	The Jewish Festival of Booths, celebrated in the autumn.
Synagogue	●	●	A Jewish place of worship.
Tishrei	●	●	The three plants of the lulav, and etrog that represent the plants that helped the Jews in the desert.
Torah	●	●	A palm branch, a myrtle branch and two willow branches bound together.
Ushpizin	●	●	A temporary shelter with a roof made from plants, built during Sukkot.
