

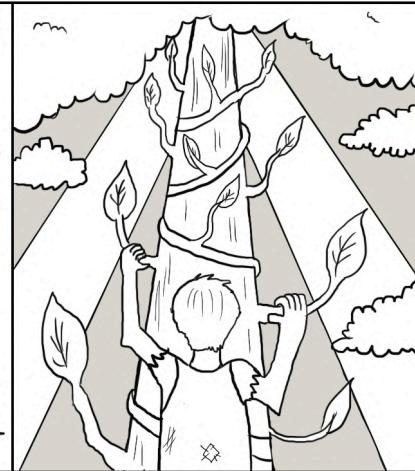
Once upon a time, there lived a poor boy called Jack. Jack lived with his mother and their old cow.

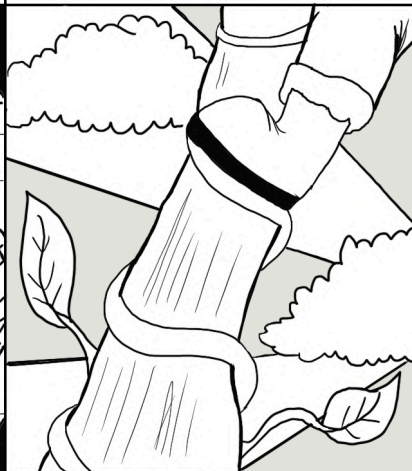

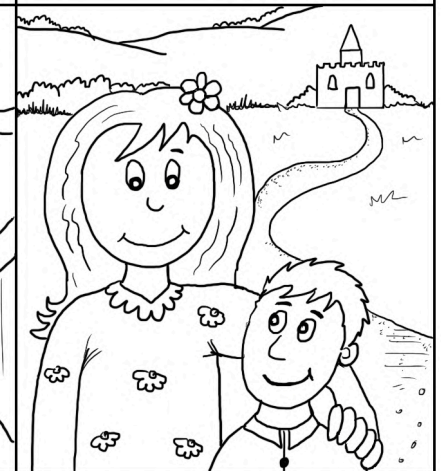
Whilst the giant slept, Jack jumped out of the cupboard and took the hen and the harp.



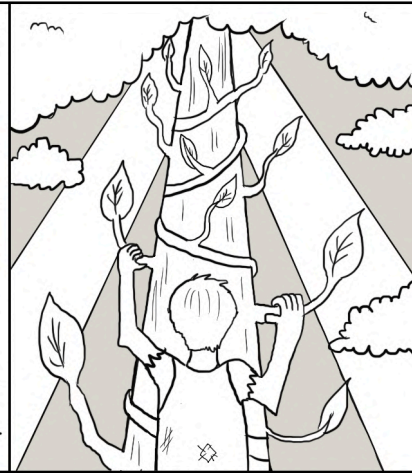
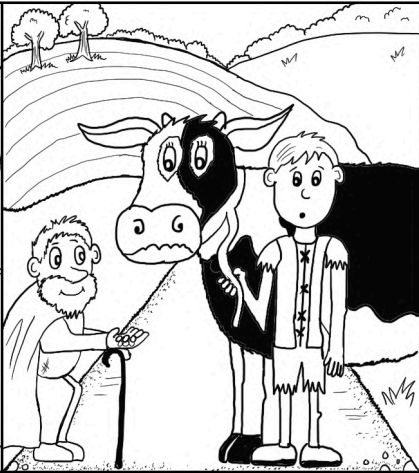
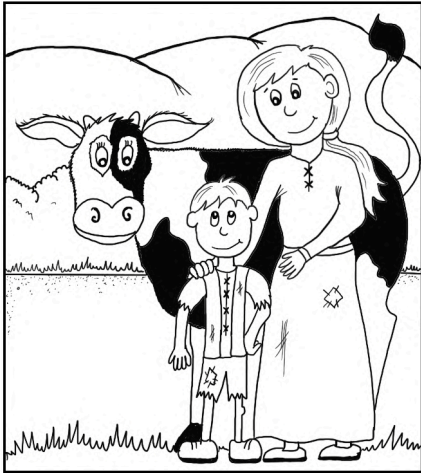
The giant woke up and shouted, "Fee, fi, fo, fum!" He chased after Jack, who was climbing down the beanstalk.

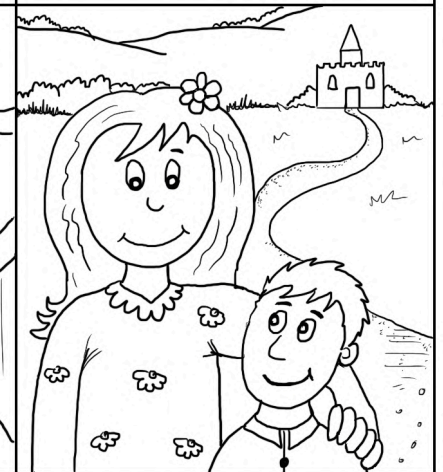
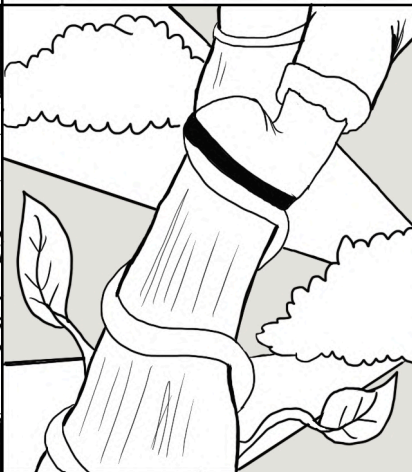
