A) Can you label the 7 most common units of time measurement?

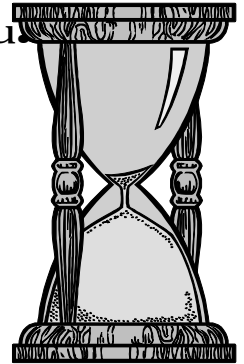
s, m, h, d, w, m, y
