<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>First Person</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>Tells you about what happened in the past.</p>	<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Past Tense</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>A sentence that asks something.</p>
<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Question</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>Compares different things and usually uses the words 'like' or 'as'.</p>	<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Simile</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>Used to show where letters have been missed out and to show when something belongs to somebody.</p>
<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Apostrophe</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>A letter, or group of letters, added to the beginning of a word to change its meaning.</p>	<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Prefix</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>When the writer speaks about someone or something else.</p>

<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Third Person</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>Giving human qualities to animals or objects.</p>	<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Personification</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>A word with one syllable.</p>
<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Monosyllable</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>When a group of words, all beginning with the same letter sound, are placed close together.</p>	<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Alliteration</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>All letters except a, e, i, o and u.</p>
<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Consonant</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>Words that sound the same but have different spellings and different meanings.</p>	<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Homophone</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>A sentence with a main clause and a subordinate clause.</p>
<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Complex Sentence</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>A way of remembering the spelling of tricky words.</p>	<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Mnemonic</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>When the sound of the word is similar to the sound of the thing it describes.</p>

<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Onomatopoeia</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>When the writer speaks to the reader.</p>	<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Second Person</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>A noun that refers to a thing, place or person by name.</p>
<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Proper Noun</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>Used at the end of a question instead of a full stop.</p>	<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Question Mark</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>A conversation between two (or more) people.</p>
<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Dialogue</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>A part of speech that describes a verb.</p>	<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Adverb</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>A noun that refers to a group of people, animals or things.</p>
<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Collective Noun</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>A group of words that contains a verb. It may be part of a sentence or a complete sentence by itself.</p>	<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Clause</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>When you write down the actual words that are spoken and use speech marks.</p>

<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Direct Speech</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>Compares different things. They suggest that two things are the same.</p>	<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Metaphor</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>A noun that refers to more than one thing or person.</p>
<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Plural Noun</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>The person or thing that carries out the action of a verb.</p>	<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Subject</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>Shows the relationship between one word and another.</p>
<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Preposition</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>Words that imply something small.</p>	<p><u>Is this the answer?</u></p> <p><b>Diminutives</b></p>	<p><u>The Next Definition...</u></p> <p>A sentence that tells someone to do something.</p>
