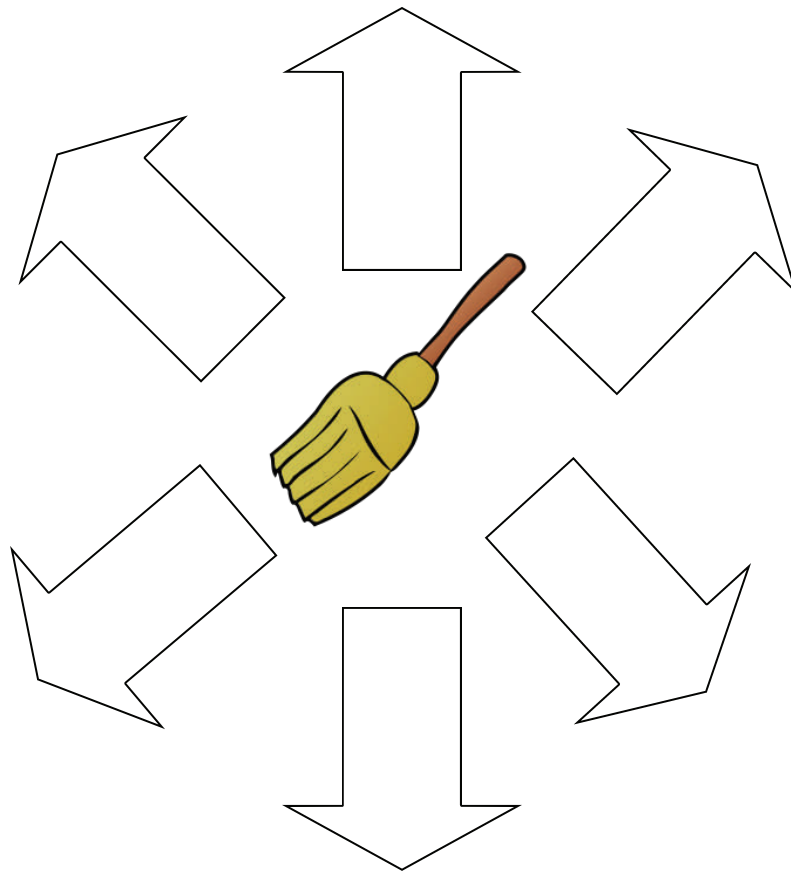
Mind Map For "Room on the Broom"
